MISUMI Industrial Park—Japan's First Integrated Industrial Complex

MISUMI Group Inc. (headquartered in Tokyo; Tadashi Saegusa, president and CEO) has established MISUMI Industrial Park, bringing together a number of machine parts manufacturers in a single integrated facility, the first of its kind in Japan. Located in Akamatsudai, Kita-ku, in the city of Kobe, it commenced first-phase operations in October 2007 with the goal of going fully operational in the 2009 fiscal year.

By inducing cooperating manufacturers now largely located in eastern Japan to establish a presence in western Japan, MISUMI Industrial Park will help distribute the risk to product supply posed by natural disasters and other causes. It will also reduce logistics costs by its proximity to the MISUMI Group's West Japan Distribution Center in the city of Sanda in Hyogo Prefecture. The MISUMI Group, as a behind-the-scenes player in the manufacturing industry, sees the distribution of natural disaster risk in particular as an important effort toward fulfilling its social responsibilities.

For the participating manufacturers, MISUMI Industrial Park provides a number of advantages: the multi-user space will reduce investment costs for land and construction, running costs will be reduced by collective use of energy infrastructure, and meeting rooms and other facilities will also be available for common use.

Strong partnership between the MISUMI Group and the cooperating manufacturers has resulted in the creation of a new type of integrated industrial facility that larger corporations could not have achieved, broadening the field for machine parts manufacturers to make the most of their technological strengths. In future, the MISUMI Group intends to help develop their technology with a view toward the global market, and thus contribute to the preservation of Japan's manufacturing tradition.
