Announcing the Relocation of our Head Office

In FY2011 (ending March 2012), our business has grown to surpass ¥130 billion in consolidated sales with 140,000 customers in 50 countries. The MISUMI Group now employs about 5,600 people globally.

As the number of employees has increased, we have run out of space in our head office and Toyo Central Building office. As a result, we have decided to relocate our head offices. The relocation will enable us to consolidate head office functions, use office space more efficiently, enhance functionality and drive further operational efficiencies.
